From the moment they come into foster care and through to adulthood, Promises2Kids provides the hope, support, and opportunities these special individuals need to change their lives for the better... now and for years to come.

As the only organization that provides a continuum of services to foster youth from infancy to adulthood in San Diego County, Promises2Kids has served more than 200,000 current and former foster youth since 1981.

Our programs include:

Camp Connect: A program that reunites sisters and brothers who are separated in the foster care system through a four-day, residential summer camp and 10 additional day events throughout the year.

Guardian Scholars: This program, beginning in high school, works with foster youth to ensure they receive their diploma, advance to college, and complete their higher education by providing support and financial scholarships.

Foster Funds: Through Foster Funds, the Something Special program provides financial support for foster children's wishes for special requests, ensuring that foster children know that they too are special and deserving.

A.B. and Jessie Polinsky Children's Center: An emergency shelter for children who are removed from their homes due to abuse and neglect, this temporary home protects more than 1,800 children a year. Promises2Kids funds numerous programs at the center.
